# **Mobility & Presence**

Showroom:

Our showroom is on the ground floor. To enter the showroom there is a 7cm doorstep. The door is 90cm wide.

Restroom: There is a single, gender-neutral toilet in the showroom but it is not wheelchair accessible due to the small size. The toilet does not have a diaper changing station. Before 6pm, visitors are welcome to use the accessible toilet at our neighbor Melly.

Office: Our office is unfortunately not wheelchair accessible. It is on the first floor up a tall flight of stairs.

Service animals are welcome, however, pets are not allowed entry due to allergies, safety of the artworks and respecting the comfort of visitors in a small space.

# Language

Our information is usually available in both English and Dutch. Our events are usually in English but if the event is in Dutch we will announce this within the event-specific information.

## Covid-19 & Virus Safety

In the Netherlands there are currently no measures in place against the spread of Covid-19. The RIVM advises people to stay home if they are sick (this includes other contagious illnesses).

However, we cannot open our showroom and hold events without the awareness of the risk of spreading Covid-19. We would like to acknowledge that the way our society is handling the situation excludes people with disabilities and compromised immune systems, as well as acknowledge that a Covid-19 infection can lead to long term health issues and cause financial difficulties due to missed work.

We would like to remind you to stay home if you have any symptoms of a cold. Please feel free to wear a mask in our showroom or during our events. We are hoping to continue work on creating a safer environment for our visitors and staff.

For our current exhibition: On Thursdays and Saturdays we kindly ask visitors to wear face masks. We have free masks available at the door. Additionally, we encourage testing for Covid-19 before attending any events.

### Low-scent

MaMA is not scent-free, but we kindly ask visitors to enter with low/no-perfume. Many people have sensitivities to strong scents.

### Lower-stimulus hour

During each exhibition opening, we host one hour with lower stimuli- sounds and lights turned down and we ask that conversations not take place inside during this time.
